




# **Installing DesInventar Software in a PC**

## **Step by step**




## Step 1: Download the setup


- Go to [www.desinventar.net](http://www.desinventar.net). Click in the “Download” tab.



- Click on the Windows installer. Please note that you will not be able to run DesInventar in a Mac.



- The system will be saved automatically in the “Program Files (x86)” folder:



## Step 2: Installing the setup

- Once downloaded, open your setup by double clicking:



- Select your language and continue:




- Accept the terms and conditions



- The software will be installed in your machine and you are ready to work.

### Step 3: Opening DesInventar software

- Click on the Start button. In “All programs”, you will see a folder called DesInventar Server. Open it and **right-click** in the DesInventar Monitor (the one with the following logo: ) and **run it as Administrator**. Please note that if you do not run the system as Administrator, it will not open.



- To make sure that the software is running, go to the bar on the bottom right of your screen. Right-click in the DesInventar Monitor logo and make sure you started the system. You can also double-click; a new window will open and you choose “Start”.



## Step 4: Running DesInventar in your browser

- Open your internet browser (Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Chrome...).
- Type down the following address: <http://localhost:8081/>
- By doing this, as you started your DesInventar software in the previous step, your computer will automatically run the software in your browser. It will look like this:
